



I-65 Northwest Indiana Expansion Project

93rd Avenue to be closed at I-65

Beginning on or after July 10, the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) is alerting drivers that 93rd Avenue will be closed at I-65 in Lake County for resurfacing.

The closure is expected to last four to six weeks and the posted detour will follow 101st Avenue.

During this time, access to all local businesses along 93rd Avenue will be maintained. A pedestrian walking path will also remain accessible.

■ A new shoulder will be constructed and the existing lanes restriped to accommodate three lanes in each direction on I-65 from U.S. 231 to just south of U.S. 30.

■ The outside shoulder and existing lanes will be resurfaced and a third lane and inside shoulder will be constructed in the median on I-65 just south of S.R. 2 to U.S. 231.

● Mainline I-65 bridge work will include structure widening and/or resurfacing.

● Crossing overpasses will have rehab and/or resurfacing (short-term closures will occur).

■ Northbound and southbound I-65 bridges over the Kankakee River will be replaced.
